## **Property Mgt. Favour report/concerns:**

The Board discussed the renegotiation of the Allied waste contract. There will be a consideration of other bids and fine print details.

#### Outdoor carpeting:

The Board will need to expedite the pricing for outdoor carpeting for the stair. There are currently at least six units requiring repair.

The building 7 dumpster fence and gate has been repaired.

FHA reinstatement has been denied due to high numbers of non-payments by unit owners.

Unit 3J (Adams) has asked for another attempt to redeem his unit. He made a payment today of \$211. He owes \$262, his HOA is \$158. If he has another delinquency the Board will continue to pursue foreclosure.

The Board reviewed the slides in preparation for the annual HOA meeting scheduled for November 15, 2012 at 6:00 p.m.

The discussion also included the usage of the grass area behind buildings 2 and 3 as a play area, grilling pad (concrete), and Dog Park. There is also a possibility of utilizing space by building 4 and 8 and 9 for an additional grilling pad.

Pet Pal Posting will be delayed until appropriate placement can be determined that does not compromise any underground wiring or plumbing.
